

ORDINANCE #07-01-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEWETT,
DECLARING PROHIBITIONS AND LIMITATIONS ON COMMERCIAL VEHICLE
PARKING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY

I. PROHIBITED ACTS

A. It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant, or his invited guest, owning or occupying real property abutting a portion of any public street, alley, parkway, or boulevard within any single-family residential district, to leave, park, or stand any mobile home, motor home, travel trailer, boat trailer, stock trailer, or any other type of trailer on that portion of any public street, alley, parkway, or boulevard abutting the real property owned or occupied by such owner or occupant for a longer continuous period of time than 72 hours within any calendar year, or for such owner or occupant to permit, allow, or suffer any such mobile home, motor home, travel trailer, boat trailer, stock trailer, or any other type of trailer owned by such owner or occupant, or his or her invited guest, to remain parked or standing on the portion of any public street, alley, parkway or boulevard abutting the real property owned or occupied by the owner or occupant for any continuous period of time longer than 72 hours within any calendar year.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person or any owner to leave, park, or stand any truck tractor, road tractor, trailer, semitrailer, bus, or any other commercial motor vehicle, or any house trailer, boat trailer, stock trailer, or any other type of trailer upon any public street, alley, parkway, or boulevard in such a manner as to block the flow of traffic upon the public street, alley, parkway or boulevard.

C. It shall be unlawful for any person or park any truck, truck tractor, road tractor, semi-trailer, bus, trailer or any other motor vehicle with a gross weight of 10,000 pounds in any City Park including what is commonly known as the Town Square.

II. PENALTY. Any violation of the Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$150.00 plus court costs.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance is effective February 1, 2007.
