TO CITIES AND TOWNS.


WHEREAS, THE CITY OF JEWETT, TEXAS contains in excess of 600 inhabitants residing within its' municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF JEWETT, TEXAS and its' citizens will benefit from the City's municipal functions being performed in accordance with the portions of Title 28 of the Civil Statutes of the State of Texas relating to cities and towns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEWETT, TEXAS that the provisions of Title 28 of the Civil Statutes of the State of Texas relating to cities and towns are and shall be enforced and the City of Jewett, Texas is and shall be subject to the provisions of said Title 28 relating to cities and towns and vested with the rights, powers, privileges and immunities and franchises therein conferred.


PASSED AND APPROVED on this 21 day of February, 1978 by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the CITY COUNCIL at its regular meeting.
