AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING, REGULATING, PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY, REPEALING ALL LAWS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, PERTAINING TO HOGS, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF JEWETT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEWETT, TEXAS

SECTION I. Hereafter, it shall be unlawful for any individual, individuals, person, persons, corporation, partnership, joint stock company, or association of persons of any kind or character, to keep, raise, hold, confine, or retain within the city limits of the City of Jewett, Texas, as such city limits now exist or may be hereafter extended, any Hog, Hogs, Pig, Pigs, or Swine. The only exception to this ordinance will be show pigs/hogs raised by those participating in 4H and any school FFA projects. Strict adherence to cleanliness, structure size, and only the number needed for show purposes shall be demonstrated. Any person violating any of these regulations, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, may be fined the sum of not less than \$200.00 or more than \$400.00 with each and every violation being a separate and distinct offense punishable as aforesaid. There will be a pickup charge payable to the City of Jewett, Texas, of \$50.00 before an animal is released to the owner. Each offense, after the first, shall be doubled.


SECTION II. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
