

RESOLUTION #06-03-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEWETT, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A HOME APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE HOME PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jewett desires to develop a viable rural community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS , certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

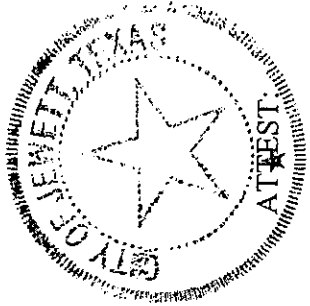
WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Jewett to apply for funding under the 2006 HOME Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEWETT, TEXAS:


1. That a HOME Program application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
2. That the City's application be placed in competition for funding under the Owner-Occupied Housing Assistance Program.
3. That the application is for up to \$275,000 of grant funds of which up to \$275,000 will be used to reconstruct up to five (5) low/moderate income standard houses and up to \$11,000 will be for administrative costs.
4. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the HOME Program.
5. That it further be stated that the City of Jewett is committing \$34,375 to the TDHCA program related costs from the following eligible match forms: force account, donated cash funds, donated site preparation and construction materials and use of same; donated or voluntary labor and professional services, sweat equity, supportive services, foregone taxes, fees, and other charges, donated land or other real property; and on and off site infrastructure work, and/or any other match eligible hard or soft costs

for those households assisted through the 2006 Texas HOME Owner-Occupied Housing Program.
